In accordance with Section 10-355 of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances, there shall be a **minimum of six supervisors** who shall be in attendance at the dance. Each sponsor and supervisor of a teenage dance shall be:

- (1) An adult person over the age of 25 years;
- (2) A resident of the county; and
- (3) A person of good moral character who has not been convicted of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude. A background check shall be conducted by the Ocala Police Department on all sponsors and supervisors.

Operation Restrictions pursuant to the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances:

a. Age Restrictions:

- (1) No child under the age of 13 years of age shall be permitted to attend a teenage dance.
- (2) No person age 18 and over may enter a teenage dance.
- (3) No person shall falsely represent himself to be under age 18 for the purpose of gaining admission to a teenage dance.
- (4) No sponsor or supervisor of a teenage dance shall knowingly allow a person age 18 or over to enter or remain on the premises of the teenage dance.
- (5) It is an exception to and a defense to prosecution under sections above if that person is:
 - i. A sponsor or supervisor of the teenage dance as identified in this application;
 - ii. A parent or appointed legal guardian of a person inside the teenage dance;
 - iii. A governmental employee in the performance of official duties;
 - iv. A vendor of the sponsor legally on the premises for the purpose of providing goods or services to the teenage dance.

b. Hours of Operation:

- (1) No teenage dance shall occur during any hours other than 4:00 pm to 11:00 pm on any Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday, and from 4:00 pm on Friday to 12:01 am of the following day, and from 1:00 pm on Saturday to 12:01 am the following day.
- (2) The dance sponsor(s) and supervisors shall remain on the premises of the dance during all hours of operation and until 30 minutes after closing to ensure that the operation is conducted in accordance with all teenage dance regulations.

c. Alcoholic Beverages: No alcoholic beverages shall be sold, consumed, available, carried upon or permitted on the premises in or about which any teenage dance is held. Admission to a teenage dance shall be denied to any person showing evidence of having consumed any alcoholic beverages or to any person who has any such beverage on his/her person.

d. City's Right to Inspection: No person who is sponsoring or supervising a teenage dance shall refuse to permit a lawful inspection of the premises of a dance by a representative of the city at any time it is open for business or occupied.

e. Signs. Signs may only be installed in accordance with Chapter 110, Ocala Code of Ordinances, and require permits issued by the City Building Department.
