SUNTRAN SERVICE SUSPENSION

Due to the anticipated impact of Hurricane Irma, SunTran services will be suspended early at 7:00 PM Saturday, September 9th. Earlier suspension of service will be at the discretion of SunTran executive staff, based on the prevailing conditions at that time. Additionally, **all** SunTran services will be suspended for the entire day of Monday, September 11th. Reactivation of services will occur once all safety criteria have been met, including wind speeds below 35 MPH and the clearance of all debris and/or other obstacles from the established SunTran routes.

We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience that this may cause to our riders, but the suspension of service is being enacted purely for the safety of you and our staff.
