Rules/Regulations:

Noise permits will not be issued under the following circumstances:

1. In a public park without the consent of the Recreation and Parks Director.
2. In any location within 500 feet of a school, courthouse or church for a period beginning 30 minutes before and continuing until 30 minutes following the commencement of the customary activities conducted at such institutions during the hours of school, court or worship, respectively, or within 500 feet of any hospital or similar institution.
3. In any location where the Chief of Police determines that the use of a sound device will deprive the public of the right to the safe, comfortable, convenient and peaceful enjoyment of any public street, park, or other public purposes.
4. Between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m.
5. Between the hours of 8:00 p.m. or sunset, whichever is later, and 9:00 a.m. on weekdays (or 10:00 a.m. on weekends and public holidays) in any location within 50 feet of any building that is lawfully occupied for residential use.

Submittal Requirements:

1. Applications for noise permits must be submitted at least five days prior to the date the sound device will be utilized.
2. Applications for noise permits that are requested for the conduct of a parade or special event on public property and as defined in the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances Chapter 66, Article V shall be submitted to the Recreation and Parks Department (828 NE 8th Avenue, Ocala, FL) along with the required Parade/Event Application and any other necessary paperwork and fees required in conjunction with same. The Recreation and Parks Department will process the noise permit for approval by the Chief of Police on behalf of the applicant.
3. Applications for noise permits that are requested for events/activities on private commercial or residential property, shall be submitted to the Ocala Police Department (402 South Pine Avenue, Ocala, FL) along with the required fees.
4. Fees: \$45 for each sound device for first day; \$5 for each sound device for each additional day.

Applicant signature indicates an understanding of the regulations governing the issuance of noise permits and that submittal of an application does not in and of itself constitute approval to amplify sound as requested. Authorization to amplify sound is not permitted until written approval by the Chief of Police is provided.
