A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, DECLARING ITSELF TO BE A COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY PURSUANT TO SECTION 163.357, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ocala, Florida (the "City Council") adopted Resolution No. 88-37 on March 15, 1988 finding one or more slum or blighted areas exist within the City of Ocala as described therein (the "Redevelopment Area"), and that a need exists for a community redevelopment agency to rehabilitate, conserve, or redevelop, or any combination thereof, the Redevelopment Area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA:


SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 163.357(1), Florida Statutes, the City Council does hereby declare itself to be the community redevelopment agency for the Redevelopment Area, and all rights, power, duties, privileges and immunities vested by the Redevelopment Act in such an agency are hereby vested in the City Council, as the governing body of the City of Ocala, Florida, to be exercised by it within the Redevelopment Area.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


